


Spring Break Analytics and Operations Trip to Seattle, WA: March 13 to March 17, 2023 [Apply by January 23, 2023](#). OPEN TO ALL MAJORS AND CLASS YEARS FROM ACROSS THE UNIVERSITY.

Experiential Learning and the Analytics and Operations Department are hosting a spring break trip to Seattle for students who are interested in analytics, operations, and technology as career paths and areas of further exploration.

Open to students from all three colleges, the experiential trip will include: site visits to employers like Oracle, Microsoft, Amazon, and Salesforce, (visits still being confirmed) networking sessions with alumni, and cultural and entertainment visits to Seattle hot spots.

COST: \$900.00 per student with financial aid available.

NEXT STEPS: Students will be notified of acceptance on a rolling basis and by January 27, 2023, if they are selected to participate in the experience. Confirmation of acceptance within 72 hours of email notification and payment is due within 7 days after acceptance documents are completed.


Professor **Tingting Jia**, finance, offers an expert review on WalletHub.





