

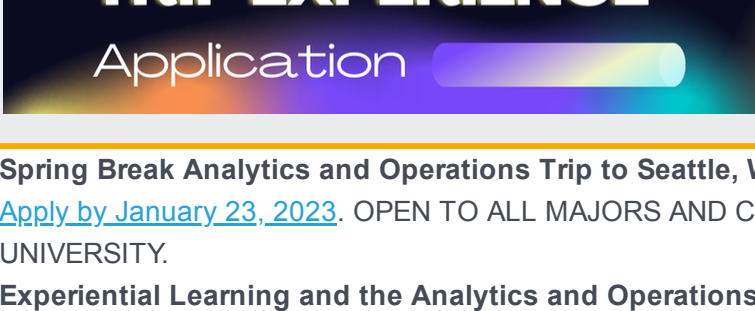

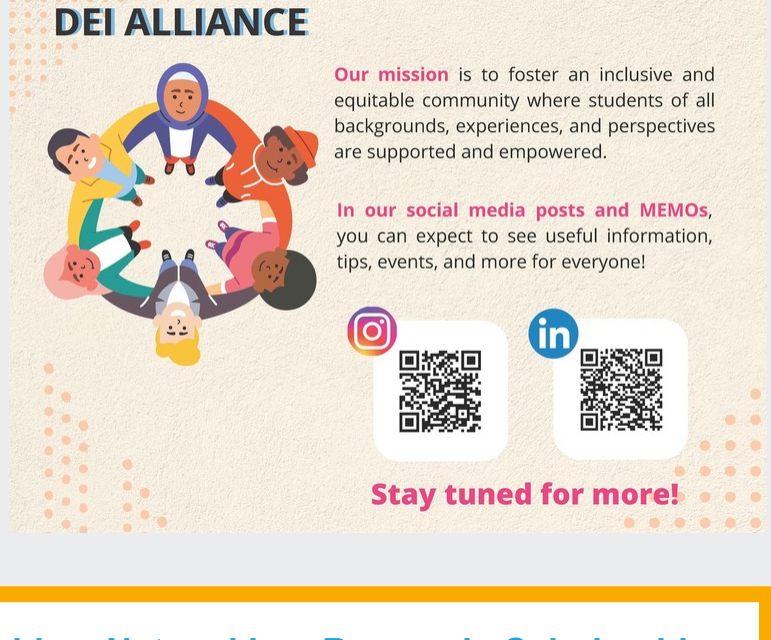
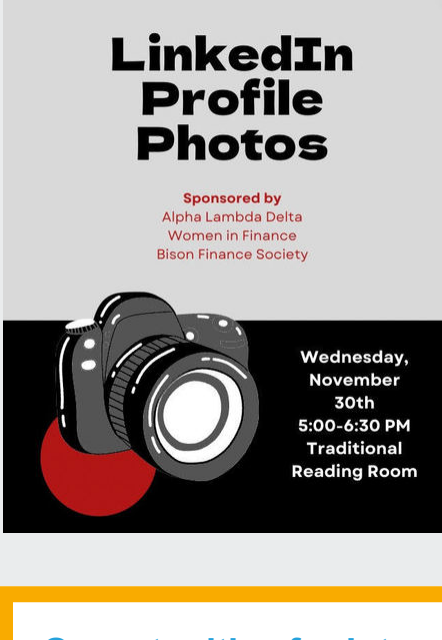
COST: \$900.00 per student with financial aid available.

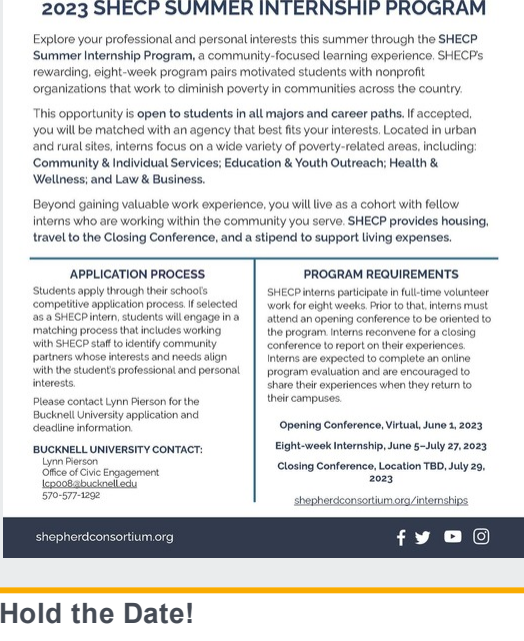

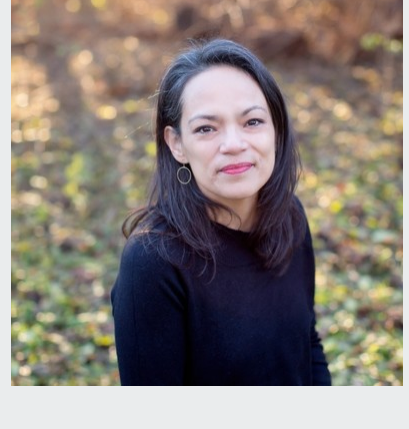
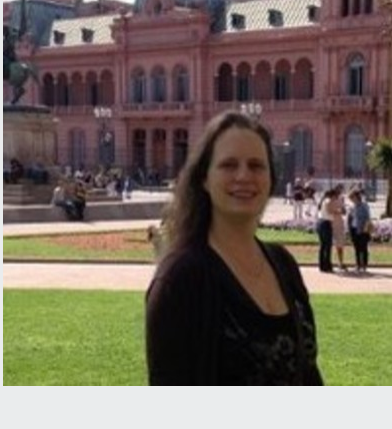
