Q&A with Kia Corthron and Bucknell

Kia Corthron is a playwright and novelist. Her debut novel, The Castle Cross the Magnet Carter, was a New York Times Book Review Editor's Choice and winner of the Center for Fiction First Novel Prize. Her second novel, Moon and the Mars, will be published Fall 2021. She received the Dramatists Guild's 2020 Flora Roberts Award, recognizing distinguished work in the theatre and encouraging its continuation. Other awards include the Windham Campbell Prize, the United States Artists Jane Addams Fellowship, the Simon Great Plains Playwright Award, the McKnight National Residency and the Otto Award for Political Theatre. Her plays, including A Cool Dip in the Barren Saharan Crick; Breath, Boom, and Force Continuum, have been produced by a number of well known Theatres and Festivals. She was the 2017 resident playwright of Chicago's Eclipse Theatre which produced three of her plays. In 2018, in partnership with Naomi Wallace, Kevin Hourigan, Theater Three Collaborative, and New York Rep, she co-produced IMAGINE: YEMEN, an evening of short plays addressing the catastrophe in Yemen and U.S. responsibility for it. That collaboration led to a current commission by New York Rep, as well as Kia's co-directing an animated short of her own musical contribution to the evening. The film later screened at the United Nations/U.K. We The Peoples Film Festival in London. Her most recent play, *Tempestuous* Elements, was commissioned by Arena Stage and workshopped a day before the pandemic lockdown. She serves on the Dramatists Guild Council, is a New Dramatists alum, and a


