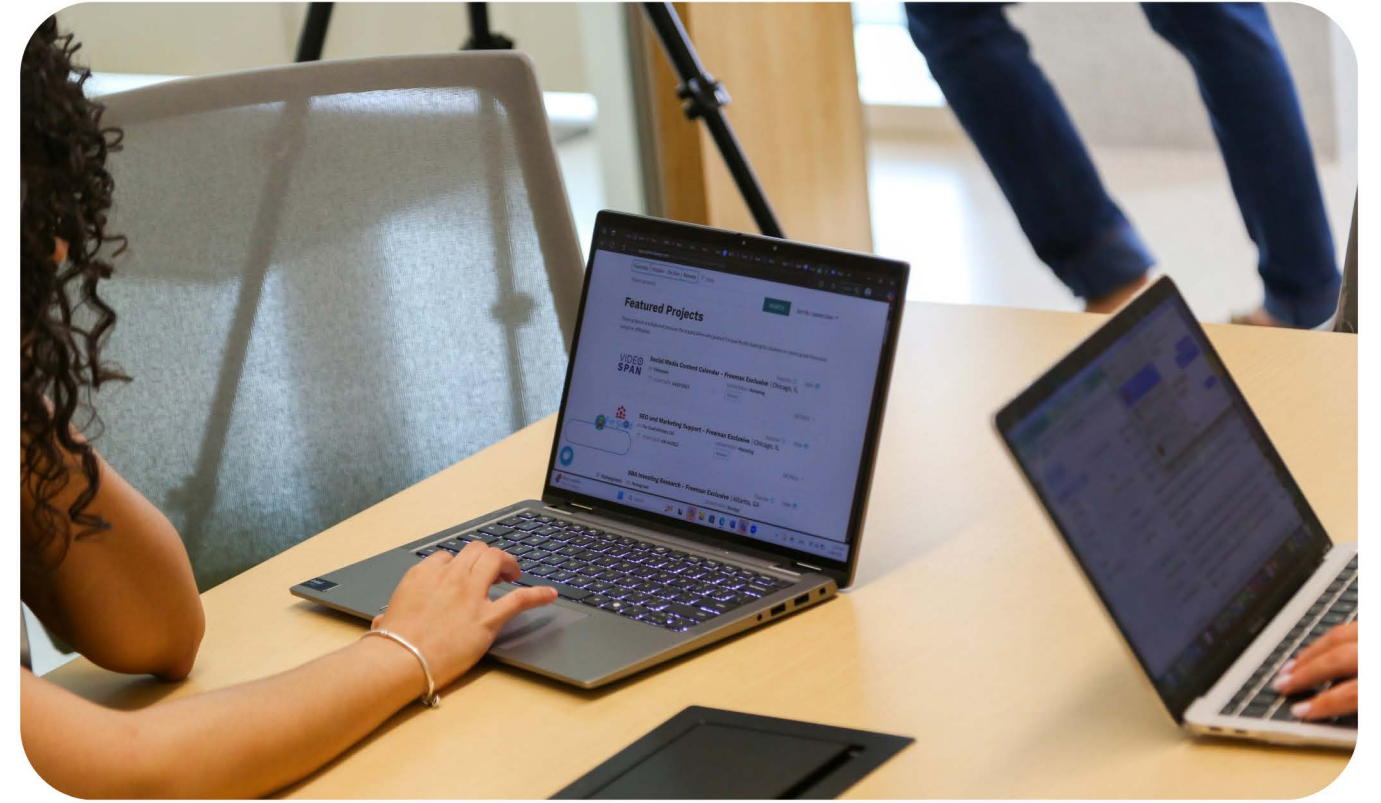

What is a Micro-Internship?

A micro-internship is a short-term, paid, professional project (lasting 10 hours) that allows students or career changers to gain experience, build skills, and explore industries. Usually remote and available year-round, these 1–4 week assignments offer a low-risk way to get hands-on experience.

What do We Need?

Freeman College of Management is looking for employers and alumni to host micro-interns for 10-hour projects in industries related to business in order to provide hands-on experience for first-years and sophomores in preparation for summer internships.

The Engagement Process



Key Features

- **Short-term & flexible:** Unlike traditional summer internships, these projects are designed to be completed in a few weeks, often on the participant's own schedule.
- **Paid opportunities:** Every project offers a pre-set professional fee for the work completed.
- **Project-based:** Assignments are specific. Examples include: market research, data cleaning, social media content creation, or lead generation.
- **Low barrier to entry:** They are open to current college students looking to explore careers and industries, with no extensive interview process.
- **Remote-first:** Roughly 90% of these opportunities are virtual, removing geographical barriers.
